Invasiveness Ranking is on a scale of 0 - 100, with 0 representing a plant which poses no threat to native ecosystems and 100 representing a plant that poses a major threat to native ecosystems (Carlson et al., 2008). The ranking is composed of four weighted categories: ecological impacts (40 points), biological characteristics (25 points), ecological attributes (25 points), and feasibility of control (10 points).
